I will be glad to host you in my laboratory in California as a visiting scholar to work on a research project on genomic characterization of "*Candidatus Liberibacter asiaticus*" associated with citrus huanglongbing (HLB) using next generation sequencing technology with DNA samples. Tentatively, the research project is set for 100 days, from December 15, 2019 to March 25, 2020. The exact beginning date and ending date can be adjusted pending on the process of your visa application. You will be responsible for your travel expense between China and US, living expense, and health insurance during your staying in California.
